


SEBI vide its Circular No. SEBI/HO/IMD/DF3/CIR/P/2020/197 dated October 05, 2020, has revised guidelines on the Product Labelling ('Risk-o-meter') for Mutual Funds. Accordingly, Product Labelling ('Risk-o-meter') for all schemes of DSP Mutual Fund basis the portfolio of schemes as on April 30, 2021 is as follows:
